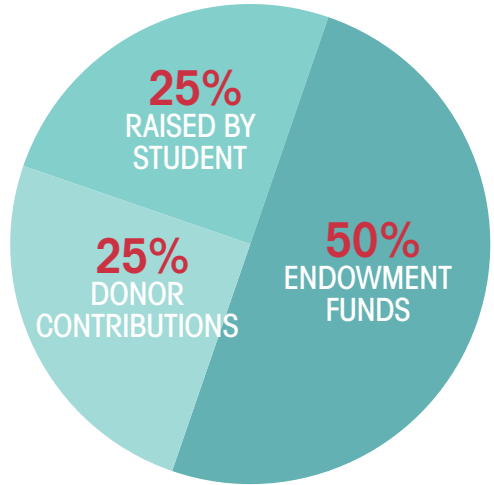




THE TUITION-FREE INITIATIVE HOW DOES IT WORK?

FUNDING SOURCES

If the seminarian raises 25% from their parish, diocese, or other organization, then donor contributions of 25% are added. Finally, St Vladimir's endowment fund covers the remaining 50% of the tuition.



What's the bottom line?

The seminarian incurs no tuition costs.
