



To apply for a Direct Loan for the first time:

1) Fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Air (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.gov. Please note that should you be selected for verification you will be required to submit a signed copy of your previous year's income tax return and accompanying W-2 forms.

2) Complete a Master Promissory Note (MPN) online at www.studentloans.gov. The MPN is a legal document in which you promise to repay your loans and any accrued interest and fees to the Department of Education. To complete an MPN online, you will need to use a PIN issued by the Department of Education. If you do not have a PIN, you may obtain one from www.pin.ed.gov.

3) Sign and submit to the Student Affairs Administrator (Mrs. Ann Sanchez) the Student Aid Report (SAR) generated during the FAFSA process.

4) Complete the loan entrance counseling session online at www.studentloans.gov.

5) Complete and submit to the Student Affairs Administrator the form below.
