MATCHING GRANT TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM Information and Submission Form for Donor Organizations

St. Vladimir's Orthodox Theological Seminary operates a need-based matching grant tuition assistance program. Each year, eligible students are notified in their letters of admission (incoming students) or financial aid award letters (returning students) of an amount of tuition eligible for matching grant funds over the course of the following academic year. (Part-time students are notified of the percentage of eligible tuition that will qualify for matching grant status; the precise amount is determined at the beginning of each semester.) St. Vladimir's Seminary will match dollar-for-dollar funds received from qualifying sources up to the indicated amount.

To qualify for the program, funds must be sent directly by an ecclesial organization (for example, a diocese or a parish) to the Associate Chancellor for Finance, Mrs. Melanie Ringa, at the above address. Funds must indicate the student for whom they are intended. Funds cannot be received from individual donors.

Student eligibility for the program is based upon an assessment of need. Need is determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) process and information provided by the student in his/her Financial Aid Application.

Donor organizations are kindly requested to submit this form with their first donation (please make cheques payable to "St. Vladimir's Seminary" with the student's name in the memo line). This form does not need to be resubmitted with subsequent payments.

Should a student withdraw from their course of study, donor funds will be refunded in accordance with the regulations and refund schedule published each year in the Academic Catalog and online at www.svots.edu/admissions/financial_aid.
