Ordained a priest in 1980, and consecrated Bishop of Katana, Syria, in 1991, you have brought to America a zeal for apostolic mission, expanding across the vast American West and reaching to the far North in Alaska. Your personal spiritual grounding has been woven into a leadership style that is effective and evangelical in zeal and fervor.

A true pastor of pastors, you are regarded by your people as a teacher, constantly finding "teaching moments" that create a climate of thirst for the truth of the Gospel.

A model of Orthodox unity on the West Coast of America, you are now, as Archbishop of New York and Metropolitan of all North America, a leading voice among the hierarchs, making Orthodoxy a unified voice and visible presence in this culture.
