ST. VLADIMIR'S ORTHODOX THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY

Pan-Orthodoxy is not just a dream at St. Vladimir's. It is *lived* here. The Very Rev. Dr. Chad Hatfield PRESIDENT, ST. VLADIMIR'S ORTHODOX THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY

Those words, uttered recently by a hierarch and Seminary alumnus from the Antiochian Orthodox Archdiocese, struck me deeply.

Forty years after the repose of the brilliant Fr. Georges Florovsky (1893–1979), our former

At our chapel, in our classrooms, and even at lunch, one cannot help but notice how Orthodox Christians from just about every jurisdiction and continent stand side-by-side in worship, study, and fellowship. You will see, among other things, how vespers and matins every Thursday are served and chanted according to the rubrics of the Antiochian Orthodox Archdiocese; how unique courses in music, liturgics, history, and more are offered every semester for Orthodox traditions outside of the Orthodox Church in America (OCA), including Oriental Orthodox traditions; how chapels have been established on campus for students from the Coptic and Syriac/Malankara traditions to learn and practice serving in their respective rites; how special scholarships have enabled seminarians from Serbian, African, Georgian, Syriac, and other churches to be educated and trained here at St. Vladimir's (and the list of scholarships is growing!); and how at every Seminary gathering or event, Orthodox Christians of every background you could imagine engage in loving Christian fellowship and high-level discussions. Oh, and one of the

highlights of 2019 was our celebration to commemorate fifty years of cooperation between St. Vladimir's and St. Nersess Armenian Seminary.

Does this kind of activity-or even *could* ithappen on this scale and with this frequency anywhere else in the world? Everywhere you look, jurisdictional disputes abound, and too many Orthodox churches are arguably becoming even more insular. But we continue to buck that trend. In fact, we are constantly in discussions to increase our cooperation with other Orthodox jurisdictions and to create new offerings in our curriculum to better cater to the needs of their respective traditions.


I firmly believe the Seminary will play an important role in bringing Orthodox unity-it's only a matter of when we as Orthodox Christians can get out of our own way long enough to allow the Holy Spirit to do His work and bring us together. But when that happens, St. Vladimir's will be at the forefront.



The Opportunity in Change

There have been noticeable changes at St. Vladimir's in recent years. Well-known professors have retired. Others have left for new administrative appointments within the Church or new academic opportunities at other institutions. A new academic dean was hired.

Of course, any period of transition is a challenge, but there is also great opportunity in this time of change! I believe one of my most important duties as academic dean is to help bring in the finest Orthodox scholars when these opportunities arise. In this process, we also have an opportunity to foster and cultivate the pan-Orthodox vision for this Seminary.

In the 2019-2020 academic year, with those goals in mind, we began a rigorous search to fill two important faculty positions: professor of patristics and professor of liturgical theology. After an extensive search in North America and internationally, making use of external reviewers to assist our in-house Search Committees in the process, I am very happy to report that Rev. Dr. Bogdan Bucur and Dr. Vitaly Permiakov have joined our faculty as professors of patristics and liturgical theology. 

Sitting with the **Suffering of Others MY SUMMER OF CPE**

My summer CPE (Clinical Pastoral Education) experience at a hospital in Connecticut was invaluable for my personal growth and future pastoral ministry. When I began CPE, I was terrified by the prospect of walking into hospital rooms and talking to patients and their families during their moments of vulnerability and weakness. I knew that I would be facing suffering, sickness, and death in the hospital, but I felt powerless to minister to people who were confronting their own frailty and mortality. I wondered what I could really say or do for someone who was in the midst of their darkest days-especially if they did not share the same religious faith or core beliefs with me.

Here, one of the main things that I learned in CPE was how important it is for a chaplain or pastor to cultivate a non-anxious presence.

While each of us will inevitably face moments of intense pain and sorrow-moments when almost any words of comfort come off sounding hollow and trite-there is nothing worse than having to face such moments alone.

CPE challenged me to sit with the suffering of others-their fear, anger, grief, doubt, and



discouragement-without running away, being personally overwhelmed, or trying to rush them through distress by offering well-meaning platitudes. Paradoxically, the more that I accepted my own powerlessness, the more that I was able to be the kind of empathetic presence that could be a source of comfort, healing, and strength.

CPE required me to take a clinical approach to my own pastoral growth and education that combined action, reflection, and a new action. Every week, I spent three full clinical days visiting with people in their hospital rooms or at a local nursing home, as well as two full class days reflecting on these encounters with my CPE supervisor and fellow chaplaincy interns. During class days, I received instruction about various aspects of pastoral care, and also presented verbatims-or word for word accounts of conversations that I had had-in order to get feedback on what I had done well or poorly. This feedback was central to improving my competency as a pastor and chaplain, but even more importantly, it helped

me to identify the hurts or hang-ups within me that prevented me from being fully present with others in whatever they might be facing, and thus allowed me to deepen my own empathy and connection to them.

I have not had the opportunity to receive such honest feedback very often, and it was one of the greatest blessings (and challenges!) of the CPE process. While it was always tempting to dismiss the insights of my peers or educator or to be defensive, they gave me new strategies to take into hospital rooms during subsequent visits, as well as a more accurate sense of my own pitfalls when it comes to relating to others. Partnering with them was one of the most rewarding aspects of CPE, and after the interpersonal that we completed together, I have noticed that my conversations with others feel much more natural and comfortable regardless of the subject matter or direction.

When I began CPE, I doubted whether I would be able to help anyone who was in the midst of suffering, sickness, and death, especially if they did not believe that Jesus Christ has already endured these for us and conquered them. But I discovered that my own non-anxious presence is the greatest gift that I can give to someone in these circumstances. Even our Lord Himself, in the midst of Gethsemane and Golgotha, longed for the presence of companions who would not fall asleep on Him or run away, and when we offer this to others, we ultimately come into His presence. CPE has been one of the single most valuable aspects of my education at St. Vladimir's Seminary, and I would recommend it to anyone who is preparing to become a priest or simply looking to deepen their own pastoral ministry.

GIVING SEMINARIANS PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION FOR MINISTRY

Last year was a seminal year for the program for Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) at St. Vladimir's Seminary. For the first time, St. Vladimir's was able to offer CPE for credit as a satellite of The Center for Pastoral Education at The Jewish Theological Seminary. Their CPE program is accredited by The Association for Clinical Pastoral Education (ACPE).

Clinical Pastoral Education is key to the theological education of future priests, deacons, and hospital and prison chaplains. CPE combines psychology with theology and gives students a chance to practice what they have learned either at a parish, a hospital, or a prison. These assignments require the involvement of a clinical site mentor, who verifies the spiritual care delivered and provides observation and feedback on the student's ministry.

A Leap Forward



In 2019, the Sacred Arts Initiative at St. Vladimir's went from "initiative" to "institute." This was primarily made possible through a second generous grant by the Henry Luce Foundation. The grant enabled the new Institute of Sacred Arts (ISA) to begin an important new integration of the sacred arts into the Seminary's curriculum. Students can now complete an M.Div. or M.A. degree with a concentration in sacred arts. Other courses at the Seminary (Church history, patristics, liturgy, and others) will begin to incorporate the relevance of the visual and musical arts.

The Luce grant also enabled the ISA to pour much-needed resources into marketing efforts, including an impressive new website (www. instituteofsacredarts.com) filled with videos, interviews, and reflections by



both Seminary faculty and other scholars and practitioners.

"We have maintained a steady stream of activity, some of which is very public and some more internal," said Dr. Peter Bouteneff, the director of the Institute. "The cumulative effect is to demonstrate a serious and viable permanent Institute of Sacred Arts at the Seminary."



Since its founding in 1938, St. Vladimir's Seminary has fostered the study of icons, music, and liturgy. The ISA now serves to extend the Seminary's mission in exploring the mutual relationship between theology and the arts by contributing to the work of people and institutions that practice and reflect on the sacred arts; engaging people and institutions of all backgrounds with Orthodox artistic tradition; and inspiring wider public interest in spirituality and the arts. The Institute will find expression in a curriculum infused with the arts, academic symposia and conferences, and publications and cultural events.




New Marketing Director joins the Press



ALUMNI IN MINISTRY

Two Serving as One

Father Mircea and Matushka Sarah Geana of Holy Trinity Orthodox Church in Springfield, VT (OCA) are both graduates of St. Vladimir's, each earning a Master of Divinity degree in 2007. Along with being in charge of an Orthodox parish, the couple has five children and run a vegetable and animal farm. Father Mircea is from Romania and Matushka Sarah was raised in New Hampshire.



In 2019, you went from being an assistant priest to being the sole priest of a parish. What is it like now to be in charge?

FM: It is an adjustment. The main difference is responsibility. As assistant priest I didn't have to handle the parish council or any administrative responsibilities. I would just show up, do the services, hear some confessions. Being sole priest is nerve racking a little bit. There are some worries and a lot to consider. You have to deal with the parish council and a lot of administration. But I am glad to say that the parish is phenomenal and very welcoming, and they helped our children transition too.

How did St. Vladimir's prepare you for this responsibility?

FM: It definitely provided a good foundation in the faith. It grounded me in the faith. The services were essential, the fact that we had services every day. It sticks with you. I do remember those first few days of Great Lent when everyone was silent on campus. We tried to do all the services just like in a monastery. I would say also that Dr. Rossi and Fr. Paul Lazor (+2020) really helped me a lot. Their courses were very practical, like Dr. Rossi's on how to deal with death and dying and marriages that are falling apart. Father Paul taught practical theology and liturgics; how to serve and what to do.

How did Seminary prepare you for being a Matushka?

MS: I can share Father's sentiment that the services of the Church provided a foundation. Having a theological education has made me better equipped to deal with discussions at our parish on controversial issues. I definitely was benefitted by Fr. Stephen Belonick (+2019) and the course on Family Systems Theory and parish life and caring for parishioners. I also benefitted from Fr. Harry and Presbytera Kerry Pappas who taught a course called Prepare/Enrich as a Christian pre-marital course. Dr. Rossi made a huge impact on me in my life and marriage and Fr. Paul Lazar was a wonderful father confessor.

How did you choose St. Vladimir's?

FM: When I was applying from Romania, I had some options. I knew I wanted to study theology and I was accepted at both St. Vladimir's and Holy Cross. It helped that St. Vladimir's gave me a better tuition package. Also, I attended a summer institute at St. Vlad's for a week or so and I met three Romanian students and they all said they loved St. Vlad's.

Along with five children, you run a vegetable and animal farm. How do you stay on top of all of that as well as your ministry?

MS: The only way we can do it is because my mother lives with us. We are very blessed to have a super supportive family unit. Everybody comes together to take care of the kids and to take care of the farm.

The Gift is in the Giving FR. WILLIAM RETTIG & HOLY RESURRECTION CHURCH

Although originally hailing from Washington state and Chicago, respectively, Fr. William and Matushka Jillian Rettig have counted the Upper Midwest as home for over fifteen years. They met and married in the Twin Cities of Minneapolis/St. Paul and were parishioners of Holy Trinity, St. Paul before being prodded to consider seminary in 2013. After graduating from St. Vladimir's in 2016, Fr. William was assigned to Holy Resurrection Mission (now Holy Resurrection Orthodox Church) in Fargo, ND. The Rettigs make their home just across the Red River of the North in Minnesota, where they keep busy caring for their two children, Adelheid and Eben, and their sprawling garden.



During The Very Rev. Dr. Chad Hatfield's Parish Administration class at seminary, Fr. Chad issued a challenge that stayed with Fr. William Rettig when he assumed the leadership of Holy Resurrection Church in Fargo, North Dakota.

"When Fr. Chad was talking about a parish budget, he noted that if every church in the OCA gave 1% of their budget to OCA seminaries, all three of them would be fully funded! His point was that with a small amount—if every parish did its part we could fund a seminary education for every worthy candidate."

Continues Fr. William, "We are so grateful that our sending parish Holy Trinity in St. Paul gives to the seminaries; between this and the St. Vlad's debt-free tuition program, Mat. Jillian and I started our ministry unhampered by debt."

Father William believes that parishes should create an atmosphere of charity. In his very first year at Holy Resurrection, the parish council embraced the challenge to offer a 1% tithe to St. Vladimir's.

"My experience at St. Vladimir's was stellar and the education, world class–I wanted to make sure that opportunity would be available to other potential clergy.

"The mission of the Church extends way beyond our corner of the world here in Fargo, North Dakota," he adds. "We are part of the universal Church. Since that first year when we took a leap of faith to give out of our budget, our parish council has increased our donations to organizations. Rather than suffering financially, this practice has encouraged our relationships with others outside the parish and increased our cohesion with other ministries within the Orthodox Church. No longer in 'survival mode,' our bishop and dean aspire to see us become a missional presence to the whole of North Dakota and northwestern Minnesota.

"We've learned that the gift for us is in the giving and in the sacrifice, when we let go of that thing we realize was never ours to begin with.
God has blessed us with this opportunity to be in the place of God, the Giver. We don't want to be like the ungrateful servant who, when he was released from his giant debt, turned

When the Rettigs arrived at Holy Resurrection, the parish had been without a priest for over a year. However, a small group of committed parishioners had been conducting reader services so that a foundation was laid and the laity felt invested in the parish.

around and demanded money from his debtor;

In response to the question, "So how is life in North Dakota?" Fr. William laughs.

a We both grew up in colder, northern US states so this is our comfort zone; by God's grace, Mat. Jillian and I both feel at home in the culture and we believe we are meant to be here."

"We were told we would be 'mission planting' when we came, but God has blessed us beyond what we expected," Fr. William says. "That first Sunday we ministered to a hundred souls rather than the forty we were anticipating. We've already outgrown our facility and we're in the process of purchasing a new building."

Holy Resurrection's "culture of outreach" also extends to local college students.

"Many college students come through our doors and we're at a point where we're hoping to see an Orthodox Christian Fellowship (OCF) started. We're also a very young parish with as many as 30-40 children on any given Sunday; sometimes Sunday morning liturgy 'has to be shouted' but we welcome the awesome responsibility of raising the next generation in the Faith."

Somewhat unexpectedly, Fr. William says that the largest single ethnic group at Holy Resurrection is Eritrean/Ethiopian.

"Here in Fargo it's a happy accident that we get all ethnic groups. Because we're one of the only Orthodox communities in town, everybody comes through our doors. It's such a picture of what Orthodoxy should look like."

Father credits St. Vladimir's with modeling ecumenical engagement for him "...in the proper, truest, best, sense of the word. The Seminary doesn't water down the differences between Eastern and Oriental Orthodox, for instance, yet recognizes the common ground and has formed lasting partnerships with institutions like St. Nersess Armenian Seminary. Now that I'm dealing with various Orthodox ethnic groups in my parish, I'm very grateful for that example."




