



**MATCHING GRANT TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM**  
**Information and Submission Form for Donor Organizations**

St. Vladimir's Orthodox Theological Seminary offers students who qualify for seminary financial aid the opportunity to participate in a need-based matching grant tuition assistance program. Each year, eligible students are notified in their letter of admission (incoming students) or financial aid award letter (returning students) of the amount of tuition eligible for matching grant funds for the following academic year. St. Vladimir's Seminary will match dollar-for-dollar funds received from qualifying sources up to the indicated amount. To qualify for the program, funds must be sent directly by an ecclesial organization (e.g., diocese or parish) to Mrs. Carmen Munoz, Controller, by the beginning of the semester (fall or spring) or term (summer) for which tuition support is being provided. Funds received from private individuals do not qualify for a matching grant. Funds received after the deadline will not be eligible for a match unless arrangements for a payment plan have been made. Should a student withdraw from his or her course of study, donor funds will be refunded in accordance with the regulations and refund schedule published each year in the Academic Catalog and online at <https://www.svots.edu/admissions/financials>.

Donor organizations must submit this form with their first donation (payable to "St. Vladimir's Seminary" with the student's name on the memo line). The form does not need to be resubmitted with subsequent payments unless the support amount changes.
