Andrew Michael Nassir was born in Hollywood, California July 10, 1941, the first child of Nicholas and Louise Nassir. Andy was named after his paternal grandfather, Andrew Nassir, an Orthodox priest who founded numerous parishes throughout North America in the early 1900s, and who was himself descended from a long line of priests in the Old Country. Later in life, Andrew frequently drew inspiration and faith from this lineage and from the honor of being his grandfather's namesake.

196X: Moved to Encino in San Fernando Valley

Until 1969: Worked for Air Force completed his military commitment

Founded Information & Communications, Inc. (ICI), primarily as software engineering company in new up-and-coming field of computer programming, collaborated with Rand Corporation on Air Force projects, including electronic guidance systems

1970: 1st son Michael born

1971: 2nd son Mark born

Very active troop leader in Boy Scouts of America with Michael and Mark, helping them to earn their Eagle rank together

Over the subsequent several years, Andy used his interest and expertise in computer financial software development and advancing higher education across the United States.

Worked full-time on developing ICI as software firm creating financial aid management systems for colleges & universities

Over the years, ICI had grown to over 30 employees and dozens of colleges as customers of its Student Aid Financial Estimation (SAFE) System. Later he collaborated with American College Testing (ACT), and continued his work as independent software firm in La Jolla until ~2020
