Coursework at the Th.M. level requires a working knowledge of ancient Greek. Proficiency can be demonstrated either by completing two semesters of instruction in Greek (or the equivalent) before beginning the program or by passing a proficiency exam at the discretion of the Program Director. In addition, Th.M. students are expected to be proficient in any language required for their chosen thesis topic. Language proficiency requirements will be formally agreed upon by the applicant and the director of the Th.M. program before admission.
