MASTER OF THEOLOGY THESIS PROPOSAL

TASK:

Admission to the Th.M. program requires the submission and acceptance of a thesis proposal. The proposal should identify the research question that you intend to pursue in the thesis. It should explain why the question merits scholarly attention and how you intend to approach it. What sources do you intend to focus on, and what method(s) do you plan to use? At this point, what do you expect will be your main argument? Proposals should include a working title for the project and a bibliography. The latter, which does not need to be exhaustive, should show familiarity with main works in the field and also include works that will be of particular value to the project. The proposal should be four to five pages in length, and should be uploaded in the Thesis Proposal step of the application.
